The Wroclaw-West Cultural Center is a local government cultural institution operating since October 2002. Our main message is the cultural activation of the local community by: - cultural education, - socio-cultural animation, - promotion of artistic phenomena.

By implementing artistic projects we shape creative attitudes, develop artistic talents but also, and perhaps above all, through unconventional forms, we teach children and youth how to behave in society.

We strive to allow the widest possible audience to enable active participation in cultural activities also socially "excluded" by their disability.

We are an institution that has been creatively activating excluded people for



many years, and our architectural adaptation and substantive experience enables us to prepare the offer at the highest level.

We are also presenting valuable cultural events: Visual arts, Performing arts, Interdisciplinary art, Music, Literature, Culture and art education, Theatre shows, Concerts, Film screenings all for children, youth and adults. We also organise and realise different kinds of artistic workshops (music, theatre, art, film, etc.).

Project idea

Together with a Norwegian partner, we want to prepare and implement a "Polish-Norwegian Literary Feast, how a dwarf met a troll".

The project "Polish-Norwegian Literary Feast, how a dwarf met a troll " is based on beliefs, stories and legends very characteristic of the people from Scandinavia and the Slavs.

The theme of the events will be the dwarf. A figure widely known from the world of fairy tales and legends. Mysterious, good, but also malicious and wayward.

In the years 2021-2024 joint educational and cultural activities will be carried out to promote culture and cultural heritage of both countries, including meetings, art workshops, exhibitions, concerts, theatre performances of Polish and Norwegian artists. Bilateral artistic and cultural presentations will contribute to establishing a deeper intercultural understanding. Thanks to the commitment to the project of known and liked Polish and Norwegian artists, authors of books, storytellers, illustrators, it will be possible to develop multidimensional cultural cooperation, visible through active participation of people from both countries in workshops, i.a. film animation, creation of illustrations and writing of fairy tales.

The result of these activities will be first of all the deepening of the culture of both countries through active participation, promotion of a lifestyle based on attendance in cultural events, what will impact the dissemination of culture and cultural heritage among the possibly broadest group of recipients. The family character of the feast will without a doubt help accomplish this fact.

All the activities are open to the public and free, they integrate the local community from various age groups (children, youth, adults) and nationalities.
