### **Project idea**

Specifically, we plan to create 12 new choreographies and song compositions (reflecting 12 months of a year). Each piece will be based on a Slovak traditional element specific for that period of the year and connected to global contemporary issue, such as immigration, vaccination and health, equality, etc. Our goal is to connect Slovak tradition with current societal questions in order to fight prejudice and depict the core of our history to be closely related to what is going on these days as well. Overall, our mission is to communicate to Slovak population in eastern regions where extremism is on the rise that today's global world does not pose a threat to our traditions, heritage and historical grounds.
