Municipality of Belitsa (Bulgarian: Община Белица, Obshtina Belitsa) is located in the southwestern part of Bulgaria in the northeastern part of the Blagoevgrad Province. The administrative center is the town of Belitsa and there are also 11 villages and the ski resort Semkovo.

The region has been populated 8000 years BC. Remains from that period have been found at the archaeological site Raven near Belitsa. There are Thracian remains near Babyak and Belitsa, some of them with big importance — a wooden sarcophagus exposed in the historical museum in Belitsa and a marble plate with the images of Zeus and Hera, now in the National Historical Museum in Sofia. There are several cultural centers with libraries in Belitsa and the major villages: Babyak, Dagonovo, Gorno Kraishte and Kraishte.



Historical museum. The municipality of Belitsa is known for its religious and ethnic tolerance. Here for centuries coexisted in peace and synchrony two religious communities, Bulgarians - Christians and Bulgarians - Muslims. A small part of the Christian community are Roma.

Project idea
