Your organisation

New Road Association was founded in 2004. Since its establishment, it has implemented successfully more than 20 projects, including projects in the field of culture. The Association collaborates well with community halls from the Municipality of Hairedin and the District of Vratza (Northwest Bulgaria), and has implemented joint projects with them. Until a few years ago, the Association supported a Roma dance group, which enacted Roma dances and traditional customs. The dance group was active between 2005 and 2010 and participated in all concerts organised by community halls in the Municipality of Hairedin. Together with community halls from the Municipality of Hairedin, the Association re-enacts various traditional rites and customs among the community, such as Tsvetnitsa (Palm Sunday) and others. Such re-enactments of traditional rites and customs are very popular among local people, and they



	<p>take an active part in them. Some Roma festivals, such as Vasilyovden (New Year's Day) and Gergyovden (Saint George's Day) are particularly popular. On 10 June every year (the International Day of Roma Women), the Association organises meetings with successful Roma women, round tables on the problems facing Roma women etc. The Association is currently supporting all activities of community halls in the Municipality of Hairedin on a voluntary basis.</p>

Ideally the idea should give an idea of what is planned, but be open enough for the partner to influence.</p>	<p>The project is aimed at promoting Roma culture in Northwest Bulgaria through the preparation and implementation of a joint cultural project (a show), created jointly both by professional and amateur artists (Roma and non-Roma). Art troupes from community halls in 2 villages from the District of Vratza will take part in the show; the art troupes comprise people belonging to various ethnic groups in the region. The project concept is to re-enact the dances, rituals and customs of various ethnic groups, with a particular focus on Roma culture; to present famous Roma musicians, Roma poets etc. We also plan to curate a photo exhibition of Roma history and Roma culture in the District of Vratza. One of the project objectives is to attract new audiences and support rural and remote populations in gaining better access to cultural resources. To this end, we plan to hold the show in 3 areas with ethnically mixed population.</p>
