Jēkabpils City Municipality is a local authority running education, culture and social institutions; it has resources, experience, finances, knowledge, material and technical base for project implementation.

The Department of Culture takes care of culture and promotes the preservation of traditional cultural values and the development of folk creativity in Jēkabpils City Municipality.

There are 4 subordinate institutions to the Department of Culture and one of them is Jēkabpils Main Library. The fundamental function of Jēkabpils Main Library is, of course, library activities; however, it must be pointed out that library activities play an important role in conservation of cultural heritage by storing, systemizing, cataloguing, bibliographically classifying, and preserving printed publications, electronic publications, manuscripts, and other documents. Besides its main functions it also is active in the field of

The idea is to ensure conservation of cultural heritage and promote its popularity among young people. There are a couple of museums in the area which used to be childhood houses of famous Latvian writers, there are churches of national importance and other culture objects that young people should know about as part of that information is included in their school program. However, young people find such information boring. By involving them in creating interactive video materials we believe such information will become more attractive for them. The created video materials will be put together to create a software – gamebased virtual trip that can be accessed from a library. A special bike will be installed in the premises of the library and connected to a TV screen. Children will have the possibility to go for a bike ride and explore the beautiful places in the region. The other part of the project is workshops. There are many crafts – like traditional ceramics, weaving, etc. – that are losing their popularity. In order to ensure that such skills do not get completely forgotten joint work with local masters will be organised to create workshops attractive for young children. Library has previous experience in organizing workshops for different age
